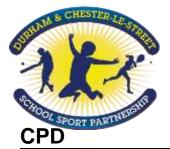

Promoting Health

Change 4 Life Club

The school have taken part in the Durham & Chester-le-Street SSP Change 4 Life School Sports Club Programme, providing suitable sports related activities and information about healthy living for students who are not currently engaged with physical activity or extracurricular sport. The school have utilised the Change 4 Life programme to provide all students regardless of ability with the opportunity to be physically active.

Gifted & Talented Year 5 & 6

The school identified talented students from year 5 and 6 to take part in our Gifted and Talented programmes. Students had the opportunity to participate in a wide range of sports that they may not have had the opportunity to take part in before. The year 6 students also took part in various sports science workshops revolving around topics such as exercise physiology and nutrition.

Durham DASH
